Hence, the affidavit filed by respondent No.3 is incorrect because necessary benefits in terms of order dated 05.09.2023 has not been paid till date to all the petitioners. It is also submitted that various contempt notices were also submitted to the respondents/concerned drawing and disbursing authorities with copy to the Director School Education (Secondary) and District Education Officer but to no effect. Copy of one such notice dated 23.11.2023 submitted to Sh. Sanjeev Kumar Maini, Principal for compliance of order dated 05.09.2023 passed by the Hon'ble High Court by Sh. Inderdeep Singh, Petitioner No.92 In COCP No.4046 of 2019 is being annexed herewith as **Annexure A-1**.

2. That despite the aforementioned facts & circumstances, the respondent have not complied with the Court

directions/not released the consequential benefits in terms of decision taken by the Government as well as by the Director School Education (Secondary), Punjab and therefore, they have rendered themselves liable to be proceeded against under the Contempt of Court's Act.

3. That in respect of other petitioners, the payment has been made, which has even been intimated to the counsel for the petitioners in response to notice and proofs in respect of one of the petitioners is also attached herewith as **Annexure A-2.**

Keeping in view the aforementioned facts and circumstances, the contempt petition may kindly be allowed as prayed and respondents may be proceeded against as per law under the provisions of the Contempt of Courts Act for willful, deliberate violation of directions given in the order dated 05.09.2023 passed in CM-12679-CII-2022 in COCP NO.4046 of 2019 read and the respondents be proceeded against under the Contempt of Court's Act and they be awarded appropriate punishment.

stated benefits already stands released in favour of all similarly placed
employees, yet in case somebody has been left out, he, on instructions,
assures the Court that the needful shall be done within a period of one week
from today.
