Context

With the accelerated breakthroughs over the last decade, Artificial intelligence (AI) is rapidly transforming how we live, learn, work, and communicate. The increasingly pervasive adoption of AI tools in education holds promise to enhance students' learning experiences and to support teachers, but it has also surfaced controversies underlying human-Al interaction and triggered new ethical issues relating to human agency, privacy, biases, and inclusion in the use of Al.

To promote human agency and human capacity development when using AI in teaching and learning, teachers and students need a comprehensive set of AI competencies to purposefully engage with emerging Al tools. To support this need, UNESCO released Al competency frameworks for teachers and students in September 2024.

By adapting and localizing these frameworks to their specific contexts and needs, Member States can prepare teachers and students to make appropriate use of Al. Guided by principles that protect human rights, enhance human agency, and promote sustainability, the frameworks outline operational recommendations across key dimensions of competencies, including the promotion of a human-centred

mindset and of ethics of AI, as well as an understanding of AI foundations and applications, AI system design, and AI pedagogy.

Following the release of these AI competency frameworks, UNESCO has been implementing the <u>Digital and AI Competencies for Teachers and Students in Member States of 77+China</u> project, financed by the South-South Cooperation fund of the Group of 77 and China. The overall goal of the project is to support Member States in their efforts to prepare teachers and students to be responsible AI users and creative and responsible citizens in our increasingly AI-driven societies.

As part of the project, regional seminars have been planned to support the adaptation and localization of UNESCO AI competency frameworks for teachers and students and facilitate knowledge sharing on effective strategies and practices for AI competency development. This is the third seminar in a series of capacity development activities planned within the framework of this project. It will be conducted as a two-day webinar specifically dedicated to the thirty-five members of the G77+China in Asia and the Pacific, while also being open to the participants beyond the region.

Objectives

Drawing on key policy guidance developed by UNESCO, including <u>Al Competency Framework for Students</u>, <u>Al Competency Framework for Teachers</u>, <u>Guidance for generative Al in education and research</u>, <u>Al and Education: guidance for policy-makers</u>, <u>Mapping of K-12 Al government endorsed curricula</u>, and mobilizing international expertise, this webinar aims to:

- provide an in-depth introduction both to the UNESCO AI competency frameworks for teachers and students, as well as other relevant frameworks;
- share knowledge and experience on the development of AI competencies at regional, national, and institutional levels; and
- facilitate the planning and development of national/local AI frameworks.
