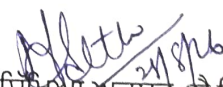

Subject: Special Campaign and Enrolment Drive for Eligible Students (Age 18+) as Voters during the ongoing Special Intensive Revision 2026 in the State of Punjab.

On the subject cited above, and as per the ongoing Special Intensive Revision (SIR), 2026 in the State of Punjab, anyone attaining the eligible age of 18 years as on 01.10.2026 can register as a voter by filling Form 6 during the Claims and Objection Phase from 13.08.2026 to 12.09.2026.

It is pertinent to mention that, youth participation forms the cornerstone of a vibrant and resilient democracy. Voting is not merely a civic duty, but a fundamental constitutional right through which our young citizens actively shape the governance and future of the nation. Ensuring that every young adult who attains the eligible age of 18 years as on 01.10.2026, is registered as an elector is vital to enhancing democratic participation and promoting inclusive electoral processes.

In this context, it has been observed that a significant number of eligible youth residing in or attending universities, colleges, technical institutions, and higher secondary schools across the State can be enrolled as Voters in the final Electoral Roll to be published on 12.10.2026 under the ongoing SIR in Punjab, to ensure that no eligible voter is left behind.

In view of the above, the Commission mandates a focused, structured initiative across all Higher Secondary Schools and Higher Educational Institutions (HEIs) - including Public and Private Universities, Affiliated Colleges, Autonomous Institutions, and Technical Institutes. You are hereby requested to issue directives to all the above mentioned schools and educational institutes under your administrative control to execute the following measures:

1. **Awareness & Sensitization Campaigns:** All Higher Secondary Schools and HEIs must initiate innovative and engaging awareness drives across their campuses. This should leverage social media channels, institutional portals, campus radio, digital posters, and interactive sessions to highlight the importance of registering as a voter and youth participation in democracy. Furthermore, Schools and Institutions must actively empower

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- and operationalize Electoral Literacy Clubs (ELCs) and appoint enthusiastic students as **Campus Ambassadors** for fostering peer to peer engagement and playing a hands-on role in identifying, motivating, and facilitating the registration of all eligible students
2. **Special On-Campus Voter Registration Camps:** Every school, college and university must organize dedicated multi-day registration camps on campus to enable eligible students to submit their applications through Form 6 within the Claims & Objection period under the SIR from 13.08.2026 to 12.09.2026.
 3. **Online Registration via Form 6:** Students should be encouraged to utilize the digital platform for fast-track processing. Form 6 can be filled out directly online via the official Election Commission of India portal (voters.eci.gov.in) or through the Voter Helpline App.
 4. **District Administration Facilitation:** The concerned District Election Officers (DEOs) / Deputy Commissioners (DCs) and Electoral Registration Officers (EROs) will provide full facilitation by deputing Booth Level Officers (BLOs) and technical staff to these campus camps to process applications on the spot.
 5. **Nodal Officers:** Heads of Institutions (Vice-Chancellors, Directors, Principals, and Headmasters) may be requested to designate Nodal Officers responsible for monitoring the progress of voter enrolment within their respective schools and institutions and submitting periodic progress reports to the District Election Authorities.

Given the paramount importance of strengthening participatory democracy among our youth, your prompt intervention and issuance of formal instructions to all educational institutions in the State will be highly appreciated.
